Our Future Bodies

Today, we will center our attention on our future heavenly bodies. This is a subject that should capture just about everyone's interest. So many people in our society are discontented with their present bodies. They spend their time comparing themselves to others (their bodies) and end up condemning themselves because they don't look as pretty. They don't realize that this approach to life and their God given bodies is contrary to God's plan and design for them. Why do you think people are unwilling to accept the bodies God gave them?

In our lesson today, you will see that Paul has much to say about this subject, much that's worth remembering and applying to our lives as believers. I have found that one of the best ways to take the Scriptures to heart is to put them in our own words. This is called paraphrasing. Sometime today or this week, write anew Paul's words from our scripture text that we will study together (1 Corinthians 15:35-58). As you do this, feel free in expanding the passage's meaning, and pay attention to the deep feelings you may be discovering in the text... and in yourself.
