I suggest to you that you break from that belief that Christians are not to rest and relax from time to time. We will study this subject in more detail during our worship hour together. By the way, this sermon topic is a first for me, how about you?

While preparing for my lesson, I came across a list of things we can do that will help us blow the dust of boredom off our busy schedules, and bring some zip to our liesure.

- **Begin an exercise program.**
- **Begin walking everyday.**
- **Start writing letters (cards) of encouragement to people you appreciate.**
- **Make something with your hands and give it to somebody.**
- **Plant a flower garden and give them away.**
- **Cook something special and give it to someone in need.**
- **Spend time at the library... Sit back and read, read, read.**
- **Plan a camping trip with one of your children, your mate or with a church group.**
