## Photocopy Phil. 2:1-8

One of our scripture text in today’s lesson is Philipians 2:1-5. Paul calls us to selfishly give of ourselves for the purpose of unity in the church. In my office is a picture of these verses on my office wall near my desk. Quite often I will read these verses to myself and ask God to help me live those words in my life. Why not make a photocopy of these verses and put them where you can read them everyday so you too can make them come alive in your life as a Christian.

**“If therefore there is any encouragement in Christ, if there is any consolation of love, if there is any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and compassion, make my joy complete by being of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose. Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself; do not merely look put for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others. Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.” (Philipians 2:1-8)**
